Number Recognition

What You Need:

- Soft items to throw (bath scrunchies, foam balls, water balloons, rolled up socks, etc.).
- Various size containers labeled with numerals 1 to 10 (boxes, baskets, plastic containers, holes in the ground/sand).

What You Do:

- Create a number line of containers, from smallest to largest. Start with the numbers your child is familiar with.
- Put items to throw within reach of your child.
- Model this activity* (Your child may only need you to model one or two numbers).
- Throw the corresponding number of items into each container.

Variation:

- Have your child throw you the items. Say, "Please throw me three scrunches."

*Gentle Reminder: Modeling involves three steps.

1. I do it.
2. We do it.
3. You do it.
