Color Recognition

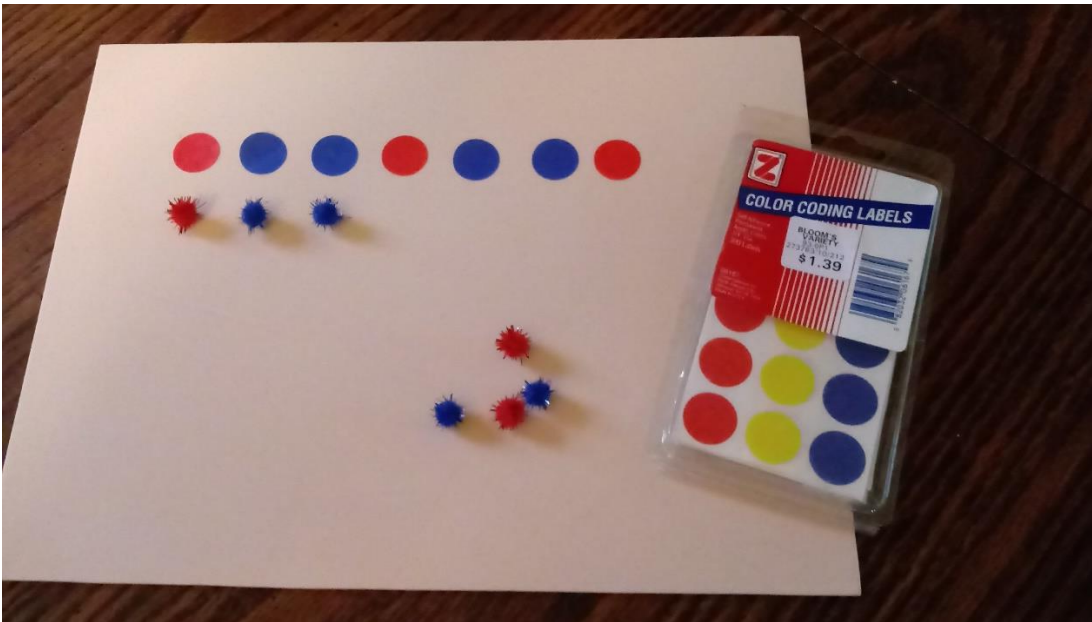
Patterns

What You Need:

- Fibre Craft Foam -Sheets or colored paper in clear plastic cover.
- Dot Stickers
- Pompoms (same color as dot stickers).

What You Do:

1. On the sheet, use the dots to create a pattern.
2. Name the color of each dot or have your child tell you the colors.
3. Have your child put the matching pompom on or below each dot, starting at the left and proceeding to the right.
4. If needed, model the activity* for your child.



Next Steps:

- Increase the number of colors.
- Have your child guess your pattern by continuing with either dots or pompoms or both.

Variations:

- Let your child put dots on the sheet and you put the matching dots and/or complete the pattern your child is thinking about.

***Gentle Reminder.** Modeling involves three steps:

1. I do it.
2. We do it.
3. You do it.
