

Nature Hunt
One-to-One Correspondence
More or Less

What You Need:

- Equal number of leaves and small objects found in nature (stones or acorns or flowers).
- Container for small objects.

What You Do:

1. Let your child find enough small objects so each leaf can have one.

Variations:

- Help your child dig enough small holes for all the small objects.
- Let your child help you plant large seeds, such as beans or peas. One bean for each hole.
- Pick flowers. Provide a vase for each flower. Instead of vases you can use toilet paper tubes.
